The Swedish Police Peace Support Operations has offered slots to International participants selected to serve as Police officers in a global peace support operation to attend the International Police officers Course (IPOC) from 10th to 21st February-2025 in Kungsangen, Sweden. As per criteria, female and male participants should have a broad experience of Police Service and be selected to serve as a Police officer in an International Peace Support Operation. The standards given by UN include meet the medical criteria outlined in the UN Medical Support Manual, minimum 5 years of policing experience, proficiency in English language both written and spoken (minimum level B2) and familiarity with MS Office applications.

All costs related to travel; medical insurance and visas are responsibility of the participants. Accommodation and meals will be provided by the Sweden. Limited funding opportunities for travel costs are available through the UN Light Coordination Mechanism on case by case basis.

- As per criteria, female and male participants should have a broad experience of police service, and be selected to serve as a police officer in an international peace support operation. The standards given by UN include meet the medical criteria outlined in the UN Medical Support Manual, minimum 5 years of policing experience, proficiency in English language both written and spoken (minimum level B2) and familiarity with MS Office applications.
- 4. All costs related to travel; medical insurance and visas are responsibility of the participants. Accommodation and meals will be provided by the Sweden. Limited funding opportunities for travel costs are available through the UN Light Coordination Mechanism on case by case basis.
- 5. It is requested that nomination of one principal and one alternate willing candidates (male/female), not below the rank of SP, along with affidavit of bearing the cost of participation, and past one year foreign training record, may be sent to this Bureau by 30th October, 2024, please.

The Swedish Police Peace Support Operations invite five police officers to the:

International Police Officer Course I, 10 - 21 February 2025, at Swedint, Livgardet, Kungsängen, Sweden.

The last day for application to IPOC I is 4th of November 2024.

Student profile

Students should have a broad experience of police service, and be selected to serve as a police officer in an international peace support operation. The officers should meet the minimum standards given by United Nations as follows:

- Female and male participants
- · Citizenship of the UN Member State he/she is representing
- Professional status as a member of the police force he/she is representing.
- Meet the medical criteria outlined in the United Nations Medical Support Manual
- Minimum 5 years of active policing experience
- Language proficiency: ability to communicate effectively in English language, in which the course will be held. Participants should be able to understand and to express themselves in English, both written and spoken (minimum level B2).
- Familiarity with basic Microsoft office Applications.

Participants who do not fulfil above-mentioned demands may be separated from the course.

The course includes two days mandatory pre-course assignment (online) before the **9**th of **December 2024**.

The aim of the course is to prepare the participant for a peacekeeping operation or equivalent so they can work effectively with the outlined objectives according to United Nations Security Council Resolutions mandate, European Union CSDP missions or an OSCE action plan.

Learning outcome

After the course the participant will be able to:

Describe vital characteristics and requirements of a police peacekeeper as well as considerations he/she need to make when supporting capacity building of host-state police agencies in line with principles of democratic policing.

Explain and understand why the outlined conduct and discipline are seen as essential elements for the mission to be successful in the host country.

General information

The course will be held at Swedint, the Lifeguard regiment in Kungsängen outside Stockholm.

The course does not include first aid training and practical security awareness training covered in the HEAT course.

Administration

a. Student Application

Applications are to be made on the attached Application Form. Applications must be authorised by the national police authority. The Application Form. together with supplementary documents and personal CV, shall be sent to Swedish Police Authority, National Operations Department. Please attach a copy of the passport for each applicant.

The last day for application is 4th of November 2024.

e. Dress code

- Clothes for physical training (indoor and outdoor).
